

# What To Do After THE CRASH!

To ensure your own safety and protection, you need to react quickly and correctly at the time of an accident, getting the right information from the right people.

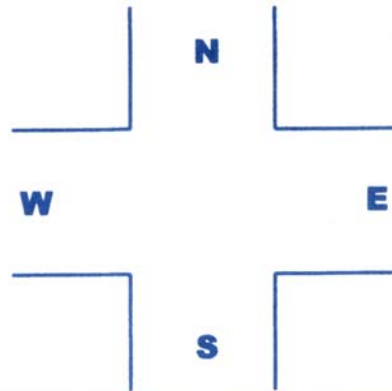
## What to do:

1. Turn off the engine, leave your car where it is, if it's safe to do so. Otherwise, drive to the side of the road or a well-lit parking lot.
2. Keep calm.
3. If you think you are injured, stay in your car, relax and ask someone to call for help.
4. Assess the situation. NEVER walk directly between two cars - if one is hit again, you could be trapped between.
5. Provide medical help to others ONLY if you are trained to do so.
6. Call the police, dialing 9-1-1 or 0
7. Do not say the accident was your fault, even if you believe it was.
8. Be tactful and courteous, even if angry.
9. Get names, addresses and phone numbers of any witnesses.
10. Exchange information: Names, addresses, license numbers and insurance information with other drivers involved in the accident.
11. Know where you want to get the damage to your vehicle repaired.
